

MINUTES
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 9, 2019

The City of Millbrook held its Regular Council Meeting at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 9, 2019, in the City Council Meeting Room.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Councilmember Jones gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CALL TO ORDER. Council President Gay called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL. Council President Gay requested the roll be called. Present were Council President Gay, Councilmembers Venable, Jones, and Hodge. Absent: Councilmember Harris. Also present were Mayor Kelley, Department Heads Police Chief Johnson, Contract Engineering Stuart Peters & Jerry Peters, City Attorney Kelly Lee, and City Clerk Anita Weaver.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA. Councilmember Hodge moved to approve the Agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Jones and passed unanimously by voice vote.

READING OF MINUTES. Regular Council Meeting June 25, 2019. Councilmember Jones moved to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and passed unanimously by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 19-44. Authorizing Mayor to Apply for Community Development Block Grant Funding for New Senior Center. Resolution 19-44 was read in full. Action on this Resolution was deferred until later in the meeting. Central Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission (CARPDC), Executive Director Greg Clark gave a review of the process in applying for the grant and estimated notification of whether the grant is awarded would be in October or November.

REPORT OF THE MAYOR. Mayor Kelley stated he is looking forward to working with CARPDC to get the grant request underway. He also thanked Chief Johnson and his department for measures taken for a safe July 4th Holiday.

REPORTS OF COUNCILMEMBERS. Council President Gay, on behalf of the Council thanked Mayor Kelley, CARPDC, and all others involved in supporting the new senior center.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS. No reports were given.

OPEN TO FLOOR. Sarah Stephens, 365 Kenner Creek Road, announced the new mustang mascot will be installed at Stanhope Elmore High School on Wednesday, July 10, but the time is unknown.

Christopher Mueller, 102 Crossgate Drive, stated his concern over multiple accidents in the area of the entrances to his neighborhood. AL Hwy 14 expansion and improvements were discussed, and Mr. Mueller was asked to meet with Chief Johnson, Stuart Peters, and Councilmember Jones after the meeting.

VOTE ON RESOLUTION 19-44. Councilmember Hodge moved to adopt Resolution 19-44. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Jones and a roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Councilmembers Venable, Jones, Hodge, and Gay. Nays: None. The motion passed unanimously.

Council President Gay announced the next City Council Meeting will be held July 23rd at 6:00 p.m. with the work session at 5:30.

ADJOURNMENT. There being no further business, Councilmember Hodge moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Jones and passed unanimously by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:14 p.m.
