

MINUTES
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 23, 2019

The City of Millbrook held its Regular Council Meeting at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 23, 2019, in City Council Meeting Room.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Councilmember Jones gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CALL TO ORDER. Council President Gay called the meeting to order, and announced that Brenda Bellizio would be the Temporary Acting Clerk.

ROLL CALL. Council President Gay requested the roll be called. Present were Council President Gay, Councilmembers Venable, Harris, Hodge, and Jones. Also present Department Heads Michael Harris, Brandon Harris, Kelley Lee, Chief Brown, Chief Johnson, Contract Engineer Stuart Peters, Gina Williams, Andrew Markley, Scott Davis, and Brenda Bellizio as Temporary Acting Clerk.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA. Councilmember Jones moved to approve the Agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and passed unanimously by voice vote.

READING OF MINUTES. Regular Council Meeting April 9, 2019. Councilmember Jones moved to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote.

ORDINANCE A 19-01. Annexation. Dismukes Property (Al Hwy 14). First Reading. Councilmember Jones motioned to waive reading of Metes & Bounds. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote. Ordinance was read in full, with exception of Metes & Bounds.

PUBLIC HEARING. Initial Zoning Request. Dismukes Property (Al Hwy 14). President Gay Opened Public hearing. Called for anyone present to comment. Bob Wall was present to represent Dismukes. No Comments were made. Public Hearing was closed.

ORDINANCE Z19-01. Initial Zoning Request. Dismukes Property. Initial Zoning of B -3 (Highway Commercial) and M – 1 (Light Industry). First Reading. Ordinance was read in full, with exception of Metes & Bounds.

BUSINESS LICENSE REVOCATION OR REFUSAL OF RENEWAL.

Smokehouse BBQ, Tabled 4-9-19. Councilmember Hodge made a motion to remove from table, and was seconded by Councilmember Jones. Was passed unanimously by voice vote to remove from Table for consideration.

Councilmember Hodge made a motion to not renew license and was seconded by Councilmember Jones. All Councilmembers voted yes to not renew license except for Councilmember Venable who voted no.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. Alabama Student Angler Bass Fishing Association Weigh – In; May 2-4, 2019, 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.; Millcreek Sports Complex. Councilmember Hodge made a motion to approve and Councilmember Harris gave a second. Was passed by unanimous voice vote.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. WSFA Hometown Tour On Location Broadcast; May 17, 2019, 1:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.; Village Green Park Stage. Councilmember Harris made a motion to approve. Councilmember Jones gave a second and Public Assembly Permit was approved by unanimous vote.

REPORT OF THE MAYOR. Mayor Kelley being absent, Council President Gay wanted to make an announcement that Pamela Trammell with CARPDEC was still seeking Grant ideas for the City of Millbrook and that the Council had formed a committee to address the issue. The Committee being Councilmember Venable and Councilmember Harris.

REPORTS OF COUNCILMEMBERS. Councilmember Harris wanted to say that if anyone had any thoughts about Grant ideas or need for the City, please bring them to the Committee's attention.

Councilmember Hodge wanted to mention the Federation/Kimber Tri – County Wild Game Cook-Off at the Alabama Wildlife Thursday, April, 25 at 6:00 p.m.

REPORT OF OFFICERS. Chief Johnson want to thank Councilmember Justin Jones as well as Chief Brown and Captain Campbell for attending the Public Safety Insurance Fund luncheon recently with Assist. Chief Montgomery and himself. Also he wanted to mention that Cops and Kids Day would be May 11, 2019 in The Village Green Park from 9:00 a.m. -2:00 p.m. and that Jones Drugs was having a drug take back event on April 27, from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
