

MINUTES
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 11, 2019

The City of Millbrook held its Regular Council Meeting at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 11, 2019 in the City Council Meeting Room.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Councilmember Harris gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CALL TO ORDER. Council President Gay called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL. Council President Gay requested the roll be called. Present were Council President Gay, Councilmembers Venable, Harris, and Hodge. Councilmember Jones was absent. Also present were Mayor Kelley, Department Heads M. Harris, B. Harris, Harper, Markley, Davis, Fire Chief Brown, Assistant Police Chief Montgomery, Contract Engineering Stuart Peters & Jerry Peters, City Attorney Kelly Lee, and City Clerk Anita Weaver.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA. Councilmember Hodge moved to approve the Agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote.

READING OF MINUTES. Regular Council Meeting May 28, 2019. Councilmember Hodge moved to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Harris and passed unanimously by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 19-40. Reappointment to the Board of Zoning Adjustments. Resolution 19-40 was read in full. Action on this Resolution was deferred until later in the meeting.

RESOLUTION 19-41. Authorizing Funds for Overland Lift Station Pump Installation. Resolution 19-41 was read in full. Action on this Resolution was deferred until later in the meeting.

Council President Gay called for a motion regarding the Public Assembly Permit requests. Councilmember Hodge moved to summarize and consolidate the Public Assembly Permit requests into one vote. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Harris and passed unanimously by voice vote.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. Elijah Casey Annual Car Show; May 23, 2020, 9:00 a.m. –

4:00 p.m.; Village Green Park. Request summarized by Council President Gay with the vote deferred until all Public Assembly requests summarized for consolidated vote.

Councilmember Hodge moved to approve all of the Public Assembly Permit requests. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote.

REPORT OF THE MAYOR. Mayor Kelley recognized Elmore County Commission Member Bart Mercer being present. He announced the Civitan Club was hosting the Christ Community Café at the

Civic Center the same evening and invited the Council and others to pay a visit after the Council Meeting. Mayor Kelley then read a Proclamation making June 11, 2019, Millbrook Civitan Club Day.

REPORTS OF COUNCILMEMBERS. Council President Gay also invited everyone to attend the Christ Community Café stating the Civitan Club and Robinson Springs United Methodist Church would be serving.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS. Brandon Harris reminded everyone Cleanup Day will be Held Saturday, June 22, from 7:00 a.m. till noon at the old Police Department.

Ann Harper announced the first performance of the summer concert series Tunes On The Green will be held Thursday, June 13, starting at 6:30 p.m. featuring Shackelford Lane.

OPEN TO FLOOR. Jean Landingham, a resident of Hamilton Place Apartments, requested rural transportation be considered for those needing transportation for shopping and doctors appointments. Mayor Kelley stated he had it under consideration since his last meeting with Ms. Landingham, and asked her to see County Commissioner Mercer after the meeting.
