

MINUTES
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 12, 2019

The City of Millbrook held its Regular Council Meeting at 6:00p.m., Tuesday, March 12, 2019, City Council Meeting Room.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Councilmember Venable gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CALL TO ORDER. Council President Gay called the meeting to order, and announced that Brenda Bellizio would be the Temporary Acting Clerk.

ROLL CALL. Council President Gay requested the roll be called. Councilmember Jones was absent. Present were Council President Gay, Councilmembers Venable, Harris, and Hodge. Also Present were Mayor Kelley, Department Heads Michael Harris, Brandon Harris, Ann Harper, Kelley Lee, Chief Brown, Chief Johnson, Contract Engineer Stuart Peters, employee Brenda Bellizio (Temporary Acting Clerk).

APPROVAL OF AGENDA. Councilmember Hodge moved to approve the Agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Harris and passed unanimously by voice vote.

READING OF MINUTES. Regular Council Meeting February 26, 2019. Councilmember Hodge moved to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Harris and passed unanimously by voice vote.

MILLBROOK REVELERS. Council President Gay recognized as present The Millbrook Revelers. Art Elsner, Chris Paul and Keith Yarbrough with the Revelers were present. Mr. Elsner stated The Revelers wanted to thank the City and all the Department Heads and their employees, for all the assistance and support they offer to help the Revelers to put on the Mardi Gras Parade and festival in the park. And a unanimous thank you was given to the Revelers from all Councilmembers present and Mayor Kelley to the Revelers for putting on such a quality event for our City.

PUBLIC HEARING. Funds Transfer to ECEDA for YMCA. Council President Michael Gay opened the Public Hearing and called for any comments, being none he then closed the Public Hearing.

RESOLUTION 19-30. Resolution to Approve Section 94.01(a)(3) Distributions. Resolution 19-30 was read in full.

RESOLUTION 19-31. Authorizing Funds for Ambulance Billing Services. Resolution 19-31 was read in full.

JOB DESCRIPTION. Building Custodian. Police Department. Council President Gay Asked Police Chief Johnson if he wished to speak about this job description. Chief Johnson said yes, and gave a brief explanation to the Council on the job and the need for it. Council President Gay

asked if there was a motion to approve, Council Member Hodge motioned to approve and Councilmember Venable gave a second. The new Job Positon passed with unanimous voice vote.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. Goodship Baptist Church Easter Egg Hunt. April 20, 2019, 11:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.; Village Green Park and Stage. Councilmember Hodge made a motion to approve the Public Assembly Permit. Councilmember Harris gave second and the Public Assembly Permit was approved by unanimous voice vote.

REPORT OF THE MAYOR. Mayor Kelley passed out an information flyer to the Council for a recycling program that Stanhope Elmore High School is participating in. This program will build benches at the school made from the recycled materials. The flyer contained items they will accept.

REPORTS OF COUNCILMEMBERS. Council Member Venable referenced a meeting she had, and was happy to report that the construction of restroom facilities at the Minney Masey Park were fixing to begin.

REPORT OF OFFICERS. Street Department Head Brandon Harris announced the next City Wide Clean Up Day as Saturday March 23, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Police Chief Johnson wanted to remind citizens to lock their vehicles. He also thanked the Mayor and Council for their recent donation to help victims of tornado victims in Lee and Macon County.

OPEN TO THE FLOOR. Jim Remacle of 148 Camellia Road wanted to speak of other City's recycling, solar and renewable energy efforts and stated he wished Millbrook would look into doing these types of things. He also stated he had a flat screen T.V. he was in need of disposing of. He was directed to the upcoming cleanup day for that.

RESOLUTION 19-30. Council Member Hodge made a motion to approve, Councilmember Harris second. Resolution passed by unanimous vote.

RESOLUTION 19-31. Councilmember Venable mad a motion to approve, Councilmember Harris second. Resolution passed by unanimous vote.

Council President Gay announced that the next City of Millbrook Council Meeting will be held March 26, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. with the work session at 5:30.

ADJOURNMENT. There being no further business, Councilmember Hodge motioned to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:27 p.m.
