

MINUTES
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 9, 2020

The City of Millbrook held its Regular Council Meeting at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 9, 2020, in the City Council Meeting Room.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Councilmember Jones gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CALL TO ORDER. Council President Gay called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL. Council President Gay requested the roll be called. Present were Council President Gay, Councilmembers Venable, Jones, and Hodge. Absent: Councilmember Harris. Also present were Mayor Kelley, Department Heads, Harper, Police Chief Johnson, Contract Engineering Stuart Peters, City Attorney Kelly Lee, and City Clerk Anita Weaver.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA. Councilmember Jones moved to approve the Agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and passed unanimously by voice vote.

READING OF MINUTES. Regular Council Meeting May 26, 2020. Councilmember Jones moved to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and passed unanimously by voice vote.

ORDINANCE 20-05. Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Millbrook Relating to the Adoption of the International Building Codes. Second Reading. Councilmember Hodge moved to summarize Ordinance 20-05. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Jones and passed unanimously by voice vote. Ordinance 20-05 was summarized by City Attorney Kelly Lee. Council President Gay stated the Ordinance is available at City Hall for review. Action on this Ordinance was deferred until later in the meeting.

ORDINANCE A20-01. Annexation. Hicks Property (Pineleaf Dr at Ward Rd). First Reading. Councilmember Jones moved to dispense with the reading of the metes and bounds of Ordinance A20-01. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote. Ordinance A20-01 was read in full with exception of the metes and bounds.

ORDINANCE Z20-02. Initial Zoning Request. Hicks Property (Pineleaf Dr at Ward Rd). First Reading. Councilmember Jones moved to dispense with the reading of the metes and bounds of Ordinance Z20-02. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and passed unanimously by voice vote. Ordinance Z20-02 was read in full with exception of the metes and bounds.

RESOLUTION 20-37. Authorizing Mayor to Enter into Agreement with United States Department of Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Wildlife Services. Resolution 20-37 was read in full. Action on this Resolution was deferred until later in the meeting.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. Keith Gender Reveal; June 20, 2020; 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.; Village Green Stage. Councilmember Jones moved to summarize and consolidate the public assembly permit requests into one vote. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and passed unanimously by voice vote. Request summarized by Council President Gay with the vote deferred until all Public Assembly requests summarized for consolidated vote.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. Allen Baby Shower; June 27, 2020; 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.; Village Green Stage and Gazebo. Request summarized by Council President Gay with the vote deferred until all Public Assembly requests summarized for consolidated vote.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. Loyd Voter Registration Drive; June 28, 2020; 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.; Village Green Stage. Request summarized by Council President Gay with the vote deferred until all Public Assembly requests summarized for consolidated vote.

PUBLIC ASSEMBLY PERMIT. Steele Going Away Party; July 18, 2020; All Day; Legacy Park Pavilion. Request summarized by Council President Gay. Councilmember Hodge moved to approve all of the Public Assembly Permit requests. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote.

REPORT OF THE MAYOR. Mayor Kelley recognized Chief Johnson and thanked him, Assistant Chief Montgomery, the entire senior staff, and all officers for putting their lives on the line every day to protect our residents, especially during these trying times.

REPORTS OF COUNCILMEMBERS. Councilmember Venable thanked the police department for keeping Millbrook safe during difficult times.

Councilmember Hodge also thanked the police department for their efforts.

Councilmember Gay reflected on attending Cops and Kids Day with his children and thanked the police department for building community relations.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS. No reports were given.

OPEN TO FLOOR. Chief Johnson announced his daughter is co-captain of the SEHS cheerleaders for 2021, and thanked numerous residents for their kind words of support, offerings of food, and general support of the police department.

Pamela Trammell of Central Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission (CARPDC) gave an update on the senior center progress, announced current grants that are available, and stated a food box program is in place for those in need during the COVID-19 crisis. She also announced her departure from CARPDC will be June 12th, but she will assist with the senior center project until someone takes her place.

VOTE ON ORDINANCE 20-05. Councilmember Jones moved to adopt Ordinance 20-05. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and a roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Councilmembers Venable, Jones, Hodge, and Gay. Nays: None. The motion passed unanimously by those present.

VOTE ON RESOLUTION 20-37. Councilmember Hodge moved to adopt Resolution 20-37. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and a roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Councilmembers Venable, Jones, Hodge, and Gay. Nays: None. The motion passed unanimously by those present.

Council President Gay announced the next City Council Meeting will be held June 23rd at 6:00 p.m. with the work session at 5:30.

ADJOURNMENT. There being no further business, Councilmember Venable moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hodge and passed unanimously by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:21 p.m.
