

MINUTES  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
FEBRUARY 25, 2020

The City of Millbrook held its Regular Council Meeting at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 25, 2020, in the City Council Meeting Room.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Councilmember Harris gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CALL TO ORDER. Council President Gay called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL. Council President Gay requested the roll be called. Present were Council President Gay, Councilmembers Venable, Harris, and Hodge. Absent: Councilmember Jones. Also present were Mayor Kelley, Department Heads, Harper, Chief Johnson, Contract Engineering Stuart Peters, City Attorney Kelly Lee, and City Clerk Anita Weaver.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA. Councilmember Hodge moved to approve the Agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Harris and passed unanimously by voice vote.

READING OF MINUTES. Regular Council Meeting February 11, 2020. Councilmember Hodge moved to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Harris and passed unanimously by voice vote.

RESOLUTION 20-14. Authorization to Enter Into Agreement with Central Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission. Resolution 20-14 was read in full. Action on this Resolution was deferred until later in the meeting.

RESOLUTION 20-15. Authorization to Enter Into Agreement with Farmers Market Manager. Resolution 20-15 was read in full. Action on this Resolution was deferred until later in the meeting.

REPORT OF THE MAYOR. Mayor Kelley recognized Hamilton Place Apartments residents in attendance and stated it was great to see their interest and regular attendance at the Council Meetings. He also thanked department heads for making the Mardi Gras parade and festivities such a great and fun family event. He also announced the passing of retired Millbrook Building Official Douglas Burkhalter, stating he had been with the City many years and will be missed.

REPORTS OF COUNCILMEMBERS. Councilmember Venable stated Ward 1 was doing very well and that she is honored to be serving her constituents.

Councilmember Hodge stated there had been no major problems in Ward 5 and thanked the City Officials for the work they do.

Council President Gay recognized Jessica Taylor in attendance, who is running for Alabama's 2<sup>nd</sup> congressional district seat.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS. Ann Harper announced Census 2020 will go live on line March 12<sup>th</sup>, and gave a review of the importance of everyone participating. She also thanked the SEHS Jr Civitan Club and others for volunteering at the Census booth during the Mardi Gras festivities making for a successful event. Councilmember Harris reiterated the importance of participating in the Census.

OPEN TO FLOOR. Prattville resident Jessica Taylor gave a review of her interest in running for Congress and asked for support during her campaign.

VOTE ON RESOLUTION 20-14. Councilmember Hodge moved to adopt Ordinance 20-14. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and a roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Councilmembers Venable, Harris, Hodge, and Gay. Nays: None. The motion passed unanimously.

VOTE ON RESOLUTION 20-15. Councilmember Hodge moved to adopt Resolution 20-15. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Venable and passed unanimously by voice vote.

Council President Gay announced the next City Council Meeting will be held March 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. with the work session at 5:30.

ADJOURNMENT. There being no further business, Councilmember Venable moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Harris and passed unanimously by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:16 p.m.
