

**DESIGNATION OF APRIL AS
FAIR HOUSING MONTH**

WHEREAS, the month of April is recognized as Fair Housing Month and marks the 50th anniversary of the passage of the Fair Housing Act, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, which enunciates a national policy of Fair Housing without regard to race, color, religion, sex, familial status, disability, national origin, and actual or perceived sexual orientation or gender identity and encourages fair housing opportunities for all; and

WHEREAS, The City of Millbrook is committed to highlight the Fair Housing Act by continuing to address discrimination in our community, to support programs that will educate the public about the right to equal housing opportunities, and to plan partnership efforts with other organizations to help assure all citizens of their right to fair housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Millbrook, Alabama, that April 2018, being Fair Housing Month, begins a year-long commemoration of the Fair Housing Act in the City of Millbrook and urges all citizens to wholeheartedly recognize this celebration throughout the year.
